THE STUDY CATECHISM

Question 71. What is baptism?

Baptism is the sign and seal through which we are joined to Christ. **Ouestion 72. What does it mean to be baptized?**

My baptism means that I am joined to Jesus Christ forever. I am baptized into his death and resurrection, along with all who have received him by faith. As I am baptized with water, he baptizes me with his Spirit, washing away all my sins and freeing me from their control. 
