So ... why are you here tonight? Are you here because you're here pretty much week in and week out? Are you here because you come from time to time? Are you here because you're in town visiting your family? Are you here because somebody dragged you here, or because you'll feel guilty if you don't show up? Are you here because you saw our beautiful building and wanted to come check us out? Are you here because of the traditions, or the music? Are you here looking for *hope*?

I'll tell you why you're here. You're here because there is a *God*. A God who created this magnificent universe. A God who birthed the stars of Orion, the rings of Saturn, and the moons of Jupiter. A God who fashioned this world and all the creatures, both great and small, that inhabit it—the beasts of the earth, the fish of the sea, the birds in the sky.
