## ***For Your Study and Reflection This Week*** **Fourth Sunday of Easter**

### ***Acts 9:36-43***

Peter put all of them outside, and then he knelt down and prayed. He turned to the body and said, “Tabitha, get up.” Then she opened her eyes, and seeing Peter, she sat up. He gave her his hand and helped her up. Then calling the saints and widows, he showed her to be alive. This became known throughout Joppa, and many believed in the Lord. (*vv. 40-42*)

### ***Psalm 23***

Even though I walk through the darkest valley,  
I fear no evil,  
for you are with me;  
your rod and your staff,  
they comfort me. (*v. 4*)

### ***Revelation 7:9-17***

“They will hunger no more and thirst no more;  
the sun will not strike them,  
nor any scorching heat,  
for the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd,  
and he will guide them to springs of the water of life,  
and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.” (*vv. 16-17*)

### ***John 10:22-30***

My sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one will snatch them out of my hand. (*vv. 27-28*)
