**Pentecost**

### ***Numbers 11:24-30***

So Moses went out and told the people the words of the LORD, and he gathered seventy of the elders of the people and placed them all around the tent. Then the LORD came down in the cloud and spoke to him and took some of the spirit that was on him and put it on the seventy elders, and when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied. But they did not do so again. (vv. 24-25)

### ***Psalms 104:24-34, 35b***

May the glory of the LORD endure forever;  
may the LORD rejoice in his works—  
who looks on the earth and it trembles,  
who touches the mountains and they smoke.  
I will sing to the LORD as long as I live;  
I will sing praise to my God while I have being. (vv. 31-33)

### ***Acts 2:1-21***

All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. (v. 4)

### ***John 7:37-39***

On the last day of the festival, the great day, while Jesus was standing there, he cried out, “Let anyone who is thirsty come to me, and let the one who believes in me drink. As the scripture has said, ‘Out of the believer’s heart shall flow rivers of living water.’” Now he said this about the Spirit, which believers in him were to receive, for as yet there was no Spirit because Jesus was not yet glorified. (vv. 37-39)
