- **Communion in April will be delayed one week** due to the timing of Easter. We will celebrate communion on April 12 instead of on April 5.

- The Presbytery of Lake Michigan is inviting church members and friends to participate in an event in Lansing on Sunday, March 29, called **Palm Sunday Path**. The purpose of the event is to publicly voice three Christian values that Jesus identified in Matthew 25: feeding the hungry, healing the sick, and welcoming the stranger. Participants from multiple denominations will begin gathering at Pilgrim United Church of Christ (125 S Pennsylvania Avenue, across from Sparrow Hospital) around 2:30. At 3:00 participants will begin a humble and peaceful mile-long walk to the Capitol, waving palm branches and singing hymns, imitating Jesus's entry into Jerusalem that we commemorate every year on Palm Sunday. Those who cannot process may join the group at the Capitol. At the Capitol, there will be a 45-minute program including prayers, speakers, and music. There is a choir forming that is open to anyone. Clergy will be wearing red vestments or stoles. Signs promoting the Christian values of feeding the hungry, healing the sick, and welcoming the stranger are allowed. Signs with partisan messages, names of politicians, or foul language are prohibited. Weapons are also prohibited. Bring snacks, water, palms, and a joyful, prayerful heart. The event will end around 5:00. The First Presbyterian Church of Lansing is allowing participants to park in their parking lot, and will bus participants to Pilgrim UCC prior to the start of the event. Then join us at noon on Good Friday, April 3, to commemorate Christ's sacrificial death on our behalf. Then join us to celebrate Christ's resurrection at 10:00 am on April 5, Easter Sunday! We encourage you to bring a friend who might be looking for a good church home. Child care will not be provided for either Maundy Thursday or Good Friday, but the nursery will be open and available for use if needed.
